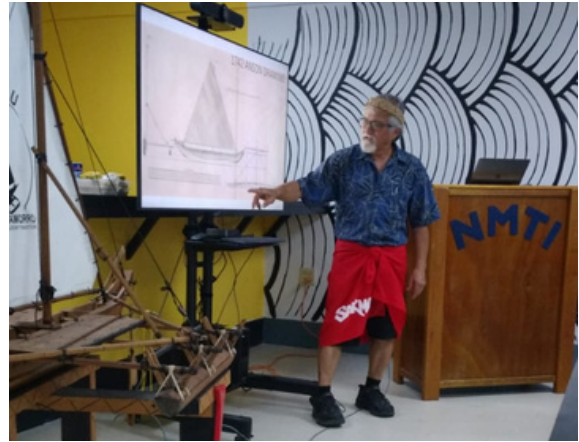
INTRODUCING COSMETOLOGY
