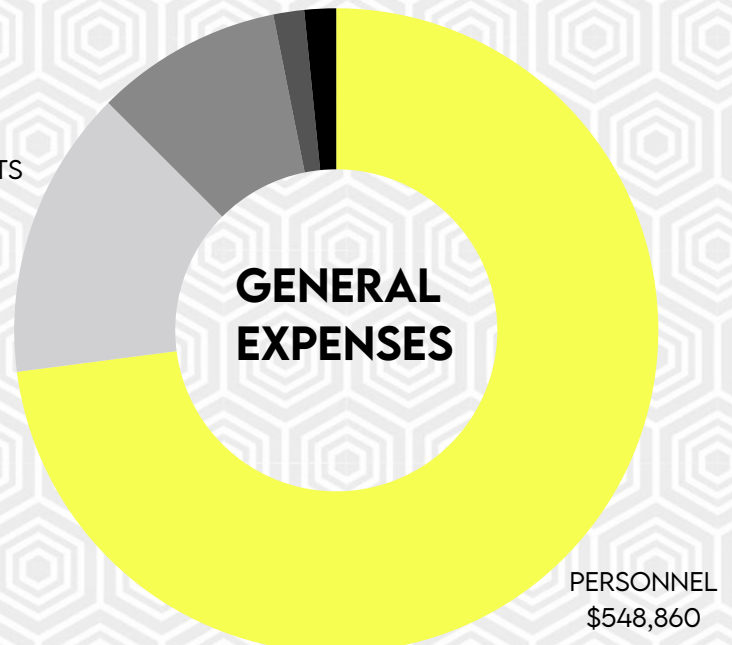
FINANCE REPORT
